A Quick Note for Parents

Reading struggles are common, and early support makes a big difference. This checklist helps you identify areas your child may need support in.

Reading Confidence

- ☐ My child gets frustrated during reading homework
- ☐ They avoid reading aloud
- ☐ They say they are not good at reading

Reading Fluency

- ☐ Reading sounds slow or choppy
- ☐ Guesses words instead of sounding them out
- ☐ Struggles with familiar books

Comprehension

- ☐ Cannot explain what was read
- ☐ Forgets details quickly
- ☐ Struggles with why/how questions

Study & Academic Habits

- ☐ Reading grades dropping
- ☐ Homework takes too long
- ☐ Teacher concerns raised

Motivation & Independence

- ☐ Rarely reads for fun
- ☐ Only reads when told

☐ Gets discouraged easily

What Your Answers Mean

1–2 checks: Needs more practice 3–5 checks: Some gaps forming 6+ checks: May need structured support
